

Some of our competitions allow us to 'double up' players, enabling them to play twice in the one round or on the same weekend.

This creates both opportunities and complexities in the selection process, as captains seek to field the best possible team for their grade.

This requires a balance between what is best for a team and what is best for the club as a whole.

As a general principle, a player should not be selected for a second game if another player who is available and of a standard deemed suitable for one of the grades misses out on selection.

To ensure equity to all players and members of the Moonee Valley Cricket Club, a member of the executive will be appointed as Duty Executive each week to adjudicate on double-up selections.

In most cases the Duty Executive will be someone who is already involved in the selection process.

Criteria such as a team's chances of finals and a player's need to play enough games to qualify for finals will be taken into account.
